JENNIE C. JONES RECEIVES WEIN PRIZE

The Studio Museum in Harlem has awarded its Wein Prize to Jennie C. Jones, reports Randy Kennedy for the *New York Times*. Jones, forty-four, is a Brooklyn-based painter and sculptor. The \$50,000 prize has been given every year since 2006 to an emerging African-American artist. It is named in honor of George Wein, a founder of the Newport Jazz Festival, and his wife, Joyce Alexander Wein, a longtime trustee of the museum who died in 2005.
