Lorraine O'Grady's Miscegenated Family Album series (1980/1994) features alongside other artists that engage personal and historical narratives across geographic lines.

Lorraine O'Grady's (b.1934) Miscegenated Family Album series (1980/1994) juxtaposes images of the artist's family members with Ancient Egyptian sculpture, creating parallels between her personal and diasporan histories. These works are featured in *Tea with Nefertiti*, a concurrent exhibition at Mathaf: Arab Museum of Modern Art in Doha, Qatar, on view through March 31, 2013.
