The newest project by the politically minded Cuban-American artist details the Castro regime's censorship of allegedly anti-Cuban writers. Fusco has gathered first editions of many of the books (including "Sartre on Cuba") and copies of memos calling for their suppression (all of which sign off with the word "Revolutionarily"). The show also has an extensive program of Fusco's films. Don't miss the grimly hilarious "The Couple in the Cage," from 1993, in which Fusco and a partner lampoon colonialism by posing as undiscovered natives of a forgotten island, only to discover that passersby and media outlets believed the hoax was for real.
