

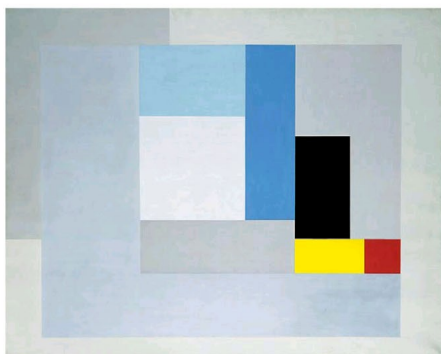


**1 DROP DEAD DIVINE**
